

Dance Guidelines

1. The music list must be submitted to the Class Moderators and Principal one (1) week prior to the scheduled dance. The music selections must be the edited versions.
2. Dancing that is provocative, lewd, suggestive, and/or indiscreet is unacceptable. Students involved in this type of behavior will be asked to leave and their parents will be called. Violation of this policy may result in further administrative action. (page 38 of Student Handbook)
3. Only one (1) guest per student.
4. The names of attending class moderators and three (3) additional faculty members must be submitted to the principal one (1) week prior to the scheduled dance.
5. There will be indirect lighting in the dance area (cafeteria). The hallway lights will be on at all times, and the security cameras must not be tampered with.
6. Chairs will be available in the hallways, and if needed, in the cafeteria.
7. Upright fans will be available for use in the cafeteria if needed.
8. All dance hours will be from 7pm to 11pm.
9. A list of student volunteers for clean-up detail must be submitted to the class moderators and the principal one (1) week prior to dance.
10. Male and female students must dress appropriately, modestly and in a manner which represents school pride. If a student's attire is deemed inappropriate by the class moderators and/or assigned faculty members, the student will be asked to leave and the parents called.
